



BUILDING INTRUCTIONS MAS


Thank you for taking part in the preventive, selective and effective control of the Asian hornet.

You have just received your JABEPRODE Selective Access Modules (MAS). The MAS consist in two cones and are the main parts allowing the building of your Selective and Autonomous Trap for Asian Hornets (Vespa velutina). They must always be mounted in pairs. To facilitate shipments, the MAS come in a kit composed of twelve elements (2x6 in total for two cones) plus two optional anti escape caps that can be clipped together:



This technical sheet aims to help you build the MAS easily and quickly.

Here is a front view and a top view of the cone once completely built:



1 – Place the plate (1) (large plate) on a flat surface. Make sure that the embossed inscription

"JABEPRODE" is at the top of the plate.

2 – Fix the three clips of the **FIRST** large trapeze (2) in the three notches of the plate (longer side of

the plate).

IMPORTANT: All clips must be positioned towards the outside of the cone.

3 – Clip the **FIRST** small trapeze (3) onto the plate, the shorter side having two notches.

4 – To assemble the trapezoids together, clip the small trapezium into the notches of the large

trapezium.

Make sure to match the clips to the notches and angle them slightly. Do not hesitate to force if

necessary.

5 – Take the SECOND large trapeze (2) and clip its base to the plate. Then insert the clips of the small

trapezium in the notches.

6 – Clip the SECOND small trapeze (3) onto the plate.

7 – To assemble all the sides, clip the last small trapeze in the notches of the two

large trapezoids (2 notches on each side of the plate, four in total).

8 - Clip the small rectangular inlet reducer (4) to the end of the cone. The hollowed-out parts of this

small plate facing upwards.

9- Repeat the process for the second cone.

10 – Optional: for added security, you can now clip the extra caps at the end of each cones, this

would prevent any escape attempts by any AH queens.

The MAS is then complete, ready to be fitted on the capture box and fixed by rivets, nails, screws,

polyurethane, or neoprene glue.
